- Is required by law, under the terms of the Climate Change Act 2008
- Commits to delivering continued action to reduce the UK's greenhouse gas emissions
- Reaffirms the UK's desire to remain at the forefront of tackling climate change globally

**!** But, the Strategy doesn't go far enough. Without **urgent action** to firm up existing policies and identify additional measures, the UK is set to miss its legally-binding climate change targets.
