FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 (FOI) REQUEST

Thank you for your request, received on 22 February 2019.

Specifically you requested:

Please a) outline what steps Lord Deben has taken to reduce his personal carbon footprint and b) what his domestic cooking arrangements are, specifically appliance type(s) and fuel used.

Our response:

- a) The steps which have been taken by the Committee on Climate Change ('CCC') to manage our organisation's carbon footprint are set out in the Sustainability Report. This includes information on the carbon emissions generated by Committee and Staff members when discharging their duties as CCC members and employees, and therefore includes Lord Deben in his capacity as CCC Chairman. The Sustainability Report is published in the Annual Report and Accounts. The latest published version can be viewed at this address:

The CCC does not hold information on activity undertaken by Lord Deben outside of his role as CCC Chairman to reduce his personal carbon footprint.
