Your request:

1. Whom and what companies are going to benefit financially, if as reports suggest that in the future there could be a ban on the present use of gas and oil heating systems for houses?
2. Do any members of the Climate Change Committee have any connection with any companies or businesses associated with the production of alternative house heating systems such as heat pumps etc?
3. Has the Committee ever considered the financial impact on home owners who in the future could be compelled to change over from their gas and oil fired heating systems such as an heat pump which at today's figures is estimated to be in the region of £10,000, £15,000?

CCC response:

1. The CCC does not hold any information on which companies will benefit financially from the ban of gas and oil heating systems for houses.
