### 1. Minutes of the last meeting and matters arising

The minutes of the 26th February 2021 meeting were agreed without amendment.

### 2. Progress report – natural environment priorities

Brendan Freeman proposed initial scores and key messages for the remaining natural environment priorities in the 2021 progress report. The Committee provided comments and suggested further areas for analysis. The adaptation team will continue drafting chapters.

### 3. CCRA3 Valuation Report findings and Adaptation Economics Study

Paul Watkiss presented some key reflections and messages from the economic valuation in CCRA3. Matthew Bell presented an update on the Defra Adaptation Economics Study. The Committee thanked them both for their presentations and provided feedback and suggestions.

### 4. CCRA3 Advice report - priorities

Kathryn Brown proposed an updated structure for the CCC's Advice Report to Government on CCRA3 with several potential charts to include. The Committee provided feedback and suggestions on how to prioritise and present the risks in the report.

### 5. CCRA3 Opportunities Mapping

Diana Jelenova presented an update on her work to analyse opportunities emerging from the CCRA3 evidence report. The Committee provided comments and suggested people Diana could interview as part of this project.

### 6. Changing CCRA risk magnitude since CCRA1

Simon Rayner presented an analysis of the changes in risk scores from CCRA1 and CCRA2 to CCRA3. The Committee provided comments and suggestions.

The Committee agreed to schedule an additional, short meeting in April to discuss the CCRA3 Advice Report further before the next committee meeting. Brendan Freeman provided an update on the work on indicators. The next confirmed meeting is scheduled on Friday 30th April 2021.
