Based on new and detailed modelling of the decarbonised power system in 2035, the report illustrates the mix of solutions needed to achieve the Government's Energy Security Strategy, changes needed to the design of electricity markets, insights into hydrogen use and the challenge of how to manage climate-related risks to the energy system.

The report concludes it is credible to deliver a reliable, resilient and secure decarbonised electricity system by 2035 and includes recommendations for government on delivering its own targets.
